<u>Vacancy for Post of Principal Community Health Care Officer</u> <u>Ministry of Health and Wellness</u>

Applications are invited from qualified officers of the Ministry of Health and Wellness who wish to be considered for appointment as Principal Community Health Care Officer in the Ministry.

II. QUALIFICATIONS

By selection from among officers in the grade of Senior Community Health Care Officer who –

- (i) reckon at least two years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade; and
- (ii) possess good interpersonal and leadership skills.

III. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

To be responsible for the effective and efficient running of the Community Health Care Services.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To be responsible to the Director, Health Services for Primary Health Care for
 - (i) supervising and co-ordinating the day-to-day work of officers of the Community Health Care Officer Cadre;
 - (ii) monitoring the implementation of health education and family planning programmes;
 - (iii) organising in-service training for Senior Community Health Care Officers and Community Health Care Officers;
 - (iv) ensuring that there is community participation in health programmes and activities organised by the Ministry;
 - (v) supervising community health surveys and studies, whenever required; and
 - (vi) analysing and submitting regular reports and statistics on community health issues to the Ministry.

- 2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Principal Community Health Care Officer in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs $22,575 \times 625 - 23,200 \times 775 - 32,500 \times 925 - 36,200$ a month.
