<u>Vacancy for Post of Supervisor of Cemeteries</u> <u>Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Public Infrastructure)</u>

Applications are invited from qualified **<u>Rodriguan</u>** candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Supervisor of Cemeteries in the Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Public Infrastructure).

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **<u>40th</u>** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should -

- **A.** possess a Cambridge School Certificate <u>or</u> Passes obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission; and
- **B.** be computer literate.

NOTE

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.

- 4. The Commission reserves the right:-
 - (i) to convene **<u>only</u>** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To be responsible for the
 - (a) administrative charge of Government cemeteries and to oversee the administration of private cemeteries in connection with the enforcement of regulations;
 - (b) upkeep of cemetery grounds; and
 - (c) keeping of registers in connection with the allocation of tombs, and the collection of grave rent.
- 2. To supervise Burial Ground Attendants (Rodrigues) (on roster) engaged in the digging, reopening and enclosing of graves.
- 3. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 4. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Supervisor of Cemeteries in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

Supervisors of Cemeteries will be required to work outside normal working hours including Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 13,270 x 260 – 14,050 x 275 – 15,150 x 300 – 15,750 x 325 – 17,700 x 375 – 19,575 x 475 – 21,950 x 625 – 23,200 x 775 – 32,500 a month.
