# <u>Vacancies for Post of Government Analyst/Senior Government Analyst</u> <u>Ministry of Health and Wellness</u>

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Government Analyst/Senior Government Analyst in the Ministry of Health and Wellness.

### II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their <u>40<sup>th</sup></u> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

# III. QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Candidates should possess
  - A. a degree in Chemistry from a recognised institution.
  - B. a Master's Degree in Food Science or Toxicology or Chemistry from a recognised institution.

OR

Equivalent qualifications to A and B above acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

2. Candidates should be computer literate.

#### Note

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.

- 4. The Commission reserves the right:
  - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
  - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

### IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To perform analysis of milk and dairy products, foods and drugs, water, sewage, fuel, fibres, oils and spirits, contaminants including pesticides and other chemical analyses necessary for ascertaining compliance with relevant legislation and for the efficient functioning of services, such as analysis for customs purposes and of materials used by Government.
- 2. To undertake toxicological analyses of body fluids from hospitals and other specimens related to cases of poisoning.
- 3. To train subordinate staff and to participate, as and when required, in training programmes in his field of competence.
- 4. To prepare and produce certificates and reports of analysis and depone in court, whenever required.
- 5. To perform analysis of pharmaceutical products for quality control purposes.
- 6. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 7. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Government Analyst/Senior Government Analyst in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs  $28,225 \times 825 - 35,650 \times 900 - 37,450 \times 950 - 42,200 \times 1,300 - 46,100 \times 1,575 - 49, 250 \times 1,650 - 54,200 \times 1,700 - 64,400 \times 1,800 - 69,800$  a month.
