<u>Vacancies for Post of Firefighter</u> Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Fire and Rescue Service)

Applications are invited from qualified **Rodriguan** candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Firefighter in the Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Fire and Rescue Service).

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates should be between **19** and **30** years of age by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should:

- A. possess a Cambridge School Certificate with a pass in Mathematics or Principles of Accounts <u>or</u> Passes obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" either (i) in five subjects including English Language and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts with at least Grade C in any two subjects <u>or</u> (ii) in six subjects including English Language and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts with at least Grade C in any one subject <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Disciplined Forces Service Commission.
- **B.** have a good physique with their **Body Mass Index (BMI)** values ranging between **18.50** and **24.99** and they should be able to undergo strenuous physical exercise. They should have a normal eyesight (without glasses or contact lenses) and also satisfy the following minimum requirements:-

FOR MALE CANDIDATES

Height : 1 m 70

Chest Measurement : 84

(normal inspiration)

: 84 cm

FOR FEMALE CANDIDATES

Height : 1 m 63

- **C.** (i) possess a Private Car Driving Licence (manual gear); and
 - (ii) be computer literate.

NOTE 1:

Selected candidates will be required to obtain -

- (i) a Goods Vehicle Driving Licence (manual gear); and
- (ii) a Service Driving Licence (manual gear) for car and van before being eligible for confirmation.

NOTE 2:

Firefighters will be allowed to progress beyond the Qualification Bar (QB) in the salary scale provided they possess a Service Motor Lorries Driving Licence (manual gear).

Note:

- 1. Candidates should produce documentary evidence with regard to paragraph **III.C** above.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence of Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 3. Candidates may be required to sit for a written examination as part of the selection process.
- 4. The Commission reserves the right:
 - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.
- 5. The weight measurement of candidates will also be taken for the purpose of computation of their **Body Mass Index (BMI)**.

The formula for the calculation of the **Body Mass Index (BMI)** is:

BMI = $\frac{\mathbf{W} \text{ (in kg)}}{\mathbf{H}^2 \text{ (in metre)}}$ where **W** is the weight and **H** is the height of the candidate

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To be responsible to the officer in charge of the Fire Station/Section/Unit/Crew for the following duties -
 - (a) to maintain and man fire appliances and equipment;
 - (b) to assist in saving lives and fighting fires;
 - (c) to carry out rescue operations and other duties related to fire safety and oil spillage, as and when required;
 - (d) to perform office duties such as keeping the Occurrence Book, answering telephone calls and raising fire alarms;
 - (e) to attend parades and perform physical and fire drills;
 - (f) to clean, repair and maintain fire hydrants;
 - (g) to refuel vehicles and appliances;
 - (h) to drive Fire Services vehicles;
 - (i) to perform fire prevention duties;
 - (j) to clean station premises and yard;
 - (k) to carry out daily testing of operational communications systems; and
 - (l) to prepare returns of fire calls.
- 2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Firefighter in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

- 1. Firefighters will be required to work on shift, including Sundays and Public Holidays and officially declared cyclone days.
- 2. Firefighters will be required to attend any training course for which they may be nominated either at departmental training unit or at any other training institution.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in the scale of Rs 18,650 x $275 - 18,925 \times 300 - 19,525 \times 325 - 21,475 \times 375 - 22,225 \times 400 - 23,425$ QB $23,950 \times 525 - 26,050 \times 675 - 27,400 \times 825 - 35,650 \times 900 - 36,550$ a month.

V. SELECTION PROCEDURE

Eligible candidates may be required to undergo various stages of the selection process which include measurement test, physical aptitude test and interview.
