# Enlistment as Trainee Meteorological Observer Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Meteorological Services)

Applications are invited from qualified **Rodriguan** candidates who wish to be considered for enlistment as Trainee Meteorological Observer in the Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Meteorological Services).

# II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **40**<sup>th</sup> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

#### III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should -

- **A.** possess a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including Physics and Mathematics obtained on one certificate or Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including Physics and Mathematics and at least a pass in English Language obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission; and
- **B.** be computer literate.

# NOTE

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
- 4. The Commission reserves the right:
  - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
  - (ii) not to make any enlistment following this advertisement.

#### IV. CONDITIONS OF TRAINING AND ALLOWANCE

Selected candidates will be required to undergo training, both theoretical and practical, for a period of at least two years both in Mauritius and Rodrigues in the various aspects of work in the Meteorological Services.

During the training period, Trainee Meteorological Observers will draw an allowance in scale Rs 16,005 x 260 – 16,525 a month.

On successful completion of the training and on being favourably reported upon, Trainee Meteorological Observers will be considered for appointment to the grade of Meteorological Observer, as and when vacancies occur.

The post of Meteorological Observer carries salary in scale Rs  $17,825 \times 275 - 18,925 \times 300 - 19,525 \times 325 - 21,475 \times 375 - 22,225 \times 400 - 23,425 \times 525 - 26,050 \times 675 - 27,400 \times 825 - 35,650 \times 900 - 37,450 \times 950 - 38,400$  a month.

#### Note

Trainee Meteorological Observers will be required to work on a 24-hour shift system including Saturdays, Sundays, Public Holidays, during cyclonic periods and extreme weather events.

# V. BOND

Selected candidates will be required, after serving a satisfactory trial period of fifteen days, to enter into a bond (which will start as from the date of enlistment) together with two sureties in the sum of **four hundred and ninety five thousand eight hundred and ninety five rupees (Rs 495,895)** to the effect that they will follow and complete the training and serve the Meteorological Services of the Rodrigues Regional Assembly, for a period of five years as from the date of appointment as Meteorological Observer.

# VI. MODE OF APPLICATION

- 1. Qualified candidates should submit their application on **PSC Form 7** which may be obtained **either** from the Enquiry Counter of the Ministry of Public Service, Administrative and Institutional Reforms, Ground Floor, Emmanuel Anquetil Building, Port Louis **or** from the Enquiry Counter of the Public Service Commission, 7, Louis Pasteur Street, Forest Side **or** from the Chief Commissioner's Office, Port Mathurin, Rodrigues **or** from the offices of the Mauritius High Commissions/Embassies overseas.

- 3. Acknowledgement of applications will be made, as far as possible, by **e-mail**. Candidates are, therefore, advised to submit their e-mail address.

Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the Application Form may entail elimination of the candidate.
