Vacancy for Post of Law Library Assistant The Judiciary

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Law Library Assistant in The Judiciary.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **40**th birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should possess -

- **A.** (a) a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained at not more than two sittings or
 - (b) Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" and one subject at "Subsidiary Level" as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations;

B. the Certificate in Information and Library Studies of the University of Mauritius <u>or</u> the Certificate in Library and Information Science of the City and Guilds of the London Institute <u>or</u> the Certificate in Librarianship and Information Science of the Mauritius College of the Air.

OR

Equivalent qualifications to **A** and **B** above acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Note

In the absence of candidates possessing qualifications at **B** above, consideration will be given to candidates possessing the qualifications specified at **A** above. The selected candidates will be appointed in a temporary capacity and will be required to follow successfully a course leading to the Certificate in Librarianship and Information Science from a recognised institution prior to their appointment in a substantive capacity.

NOTE

- 1. The onus for the submission of equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 2. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
- 3. The Commission reserves the right:
 - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To arrange and keep all library materials in order.
- 2. To charge and discharge library materials.
- 3. To replace return stock to the appropriate place.
- 4. To type and arrange catalogue cards.
- 5. To assist in shelf reading and stocktaking.
- 6. To keep statistical records.
- 7. To assist in noter-up pasting.
- 8. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.

NOTE

Law Library Assistants will be required to work on a roster basis to cover the opening hours of the Library.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs $16,785 \times 260 - 17,825 \times 275 - 18,925 \times 300 - 19,525 \times 325 - 21,475 \times 375 - 22,225 \times 400 - 23,425 \times 525 - 26,050 \times 675 - 27,400 \times 825 - 34,825$ a month.
