Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Prisons Psychologist/Senior Prisons Psychologist in the Mauritius Prison Service.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **40**th birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should -

- A. possess a Master's Degree in Clinical Psychology or Counselling Psychology or Psychology from a recognised institution <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
- B. (i) possess good communication and interpersonal skills; and
 - (ii) be computer literate.

NOTE

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
- 4. The Commission reserves the right:
 - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

IV. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

To be responsible for the provision of an effective and efficient psychotherapeutic and counselling service.

V. <u>DUTIES AND SALARY</u>

- 1. To devise, implement and monitor educational programmes relating to psychological matters.
- 2. To make referral, where appropriate, for admission to hospital for psychiatric treatment.
- 3. To provide
 - (i) psychological assessment and treatment services for detainees/inmates;
 - (ii) therapeutic needs of detainees/inmates;
 - (iii) psychotherapy and counselling to detainees/inmates; and
 - (iv) counselling services to the staff of penal institutions, as and when required.
- 4. To conduct mass counselling sessions.
- 5. To prepare reports for other services (court, police, etc.), as and when required.
- 6. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 7. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Prisons Psychologist/Senior Prisons Psychologist in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs $31,525 \times 825 - 35,650 \times 900 - 37,450 \times 950 - 42,200 \times 1,300 - 46,100 \times 1,575 - 49,250 \times 1,650 - 54,200 \times 1,700 - 64,400 \times 1,800 - 69,800$ a month.
