**Vacancy for Post of Automobile Electronics Technician**  
**Ministry of National Infrastructure and Community Development**  
**(National Infrastructure Division)**

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Automobile Electronics Technician in the Ministry of National Infrastructure and Community Development (National Infrastructure Division).

**II. AGE LIMIT**

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45<sup>th</sup>** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

**III. QUALIFICATIONS**

Candidates should possess -

- A.** a Cambridge School Certificate or Passes obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject; and
- B.** the National Trade Certificate (Level 2) in Automotive Mechanics and Electronics or the National Certificate (Level 4) in Automotive Mechanics and Electronics awarded by the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development.

OR

Equivalent qualifications to **A** and **B** above acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

**C.** Candidates should -

- (i) reckon at least two years' experience in the repair of electronics equipment, preferably in Automobile Electronics System.
- (ii) be computer literate.

**NOTE**

1. Candidates should produce written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed.
2. **The onus for the submission of written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed and Equivalence of Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.**
3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.

4. The Commission reserves the right:
  - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
  - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement

#### **IV. DUTIES AND SALARY**

1. To troubleshoot, test and repair or renew electronic engine components/devices such as sensors, actuators, Electronic Component Mechanism (ECM), ignition system and fuel injection system.
2. To diagnose, test and repair or renew electronic component, control module incorporated in mechanical/electronics systems found on vehicles such as ABS control module, instrumentation, lighting system, starters, alternators and airbag control module.
3. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
4. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Automobile Electronics Technician in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 16,525 x 260 – 17,825 x 275 – 18,925 x 300 – 19,525 x 325 – 21,475 x 375 – 22,225 x 400 – 23,425 x 525 – 26,050 x 675 – 27,400 x 825 – 34,000 a month.
