

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION CIRCULAR NOTE NO. 10 OF 2023

Vacancy for Post of Deputy Director of Shipping
Ministry of Blue Economy, Marine Resources, Fisheries and Shipping
(Shipping)

Applications are invited from qualified officers of the Ministry of Blue Economy, Marine Resources, Fisheries and Shipping (Shipping) who wish to be considered for appointment as Deputy Director of Shipping in the Ministry.

II. QUALIFICATIONS

By selection from among officers in the grades of Principal Nautical Surveyor and Principal Marine Engineering Surveyor who reckon at least two years' service in a substantive capacity in their respective grades and who possess –

- (i) leadership and team building skills;
- (ii) good communication skills; and
- (iii) a high sense of discretion, initiative and judgment.

III. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

To implement and monitor policies regarding marine and marine related issues.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

1. To assist generally the Director of Shipping in the general superintendence of the Merchant Shipping Act.
2. To be in charge of the office of the surveyors.
3. To supervise and control the work of the Superintendent of Shipping.
4. To plan and conduct examination of seafarers as required and monitor the activities of the Board of Examiners.
5. To assist the Director in –
 - (i) the operation of Port State Control of foreign ships;
 - (ii) the implementation of relevant national and international instruments relating to the prevention of marine pollution; and
 - (iii) the planning and holding of inquiries/investigations into shipping casualties.

6. To coach and train junior staff.
7. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
8. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Deputy Director of Shipping in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 71,800 x 2,000 – 75,800 x 2,150 – 82,250 x 3,000 – 88,250 x 3,125 – 94,500 a month.
