Vacancy for Post of Occupational Safety and Health Officer/ Senior Occupational Safety and Health Officer Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Labour and Industrial Relations)

Applications are invited from qualified **Rodriguan** candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Occupational Safety and Health Officer/Senior Occupational Safety and Health Officer in the Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Labour and Industrial Relations).

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their <u>45th</u> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should -

- A. possess a diploma in Occupational Health and Safety from a recognised institution <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
- B. be computer literate.

NOTE 1

In the absence of candidates possessing the qualification at A above, consideration will be given to candidates who possess a diploma in Civil or Mechanical or Electrical or Chemical Engineering from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

NOTE 2

Candidates selected under "NOTE 1" will be appointed in a temporary capacity in the first instance and will be required to undergo on-the-job training in all aspects of safety, health and welfare of workers for a period of at least six months. On satisfactory completion of the training and on being favourably reported upon, they will be considered for appointment as Occupational Safety and Health Officer/Senior Occupational Safety and Health Officer in a substantive capacity.

Note

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.

- 3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
- 4. The Commission reserves the right:
 - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To inspect all places of work including factories, with a view to
 - (i) assessing workplace hazards and the suitability of protective measures taken and/or protective equipment provided to abate or eliminate the hazards and to take appropriate follow-up action;
 - (ii) ensuring compliance with the provisions of legislation relating to the safety, health and welfare of employees; and
 - (iii) establishing contraventions, wherever required, prior to prosecution of persons, companies and corporate bodies for non-compliance with the provisions of the relevant legislation.
- 2. To carry out investigations into complaints made by employees, trade union officials, employers and public institutions.
- 3. To investigate into occupational accidents, fires and dangerous occurrences.
- 4. To deliver training, tender advice and provide information to employees, trade unions, employers, Safety and Health Officers and to the general public at large on safety, health and welfare matters and on the provisions of the relevant legislation.
- 5. To conduct enquiries regarding registration of Safety and Health Officers and Steam Boilers and to approve applications for registration of factories and issue certificates of registration, wherever appropriate.
- 6. To depone as witness in court, whenever required.
- 7. To examine plans of buildings and manuals of new machines and equipment and advise the relevant authorities on safety and health issues prior to the issue of development permits to new enterprises.
- 8. To collect and compile statistical information relevant to safety and health.
- 9. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 10. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Occupational Safety and Health Officer/Senior Occupational Safety and Health Officer in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs $21,850 \times 375 - 22,225 \times 400 - 23,425 \times 525 - 26,050 \times 675 - 27,400 \times 825 - 35,650 \times 900 - 37,450 \times 950 - 42,200 \times 1,300 - 46,100 \times 1,575 - 49,250 \times 1,650 - 50,900 a month.$
