Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Technical Officer (Electrical and Electronics) in the Ministry of Land Transport and Light Rail (Traffic Management and Road Safety Unit).

II. <u>AGE LIMIT</u>

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their $\underline{45}^{th}$ birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should -

- A. possess a diploma in Electrical and Electronic Engineering from a recognised institution <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission; and
- B. be computer literate.

<u>NOTE</u>

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
- 4. The Commission reserves the right:
 - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To assist
 - (i) Engineer/Senior Engineers (Civil) in the supervision of all electrical and electronics works, in processing requests for new installation of traffic lights and in certifying claims for payment pertaining to traffic signal equipment;
 - (ii) in the installation and maintenance of electrical and electronic traffic equipment, traffic lights and traffic counters; and
 - (iii) in the commissioning of traffic lights or any other electronic traffic/road safety devices.
- 2. To liaise with contractors (provision and maintenance) responsible for traffic lights on a daily basis.
- 3. To carry out regular site visits at signalised junctions.
- 4. To prepare and submit reports, technical papers or any written information on traffic signal equipment, as and when required.
- 5. To participate in meetings and committees, as and when required.
- 6. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 7. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Technical Officer (Electrical and Electronics) in the roles ascribed to him.
