Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Forensic Technologist/Senior Forensic Technologist in the **Chemistry/Toxicology Section** in the Forensic Science Laboratory of the Prime Minister's Office (Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity Division).

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45th** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should -

- A. possess a Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at "Principal Level" in Chemistry and Physics obtained on one certificate <u>or</u> Passes in Chemistry and Physics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
- B. be computer literate.

<u>Note</u>

Forensic Technologist/Senior Forensic Technologist may be required to undergo training as approved and arranged.

NOTE

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.

- 4. The Commission reserves the right:
 - (i) to convene **<u>only</u>** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To assist the scientific/technical staff at the Forensic Science Laboratory in forensic examination and analysis related to casework.
- 2. To take adequate measures to ensure good housekeeping in the Laboratory and assist in the maintenance of Laboratory equipment.
- 3. To assist in -
 - (i) the analysis of scenes of crime;
 - (ii) the implementation and maintenance of quality assurance and quality control; and
 - (iii) research and development related to Forensic Science.
- 4. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 5. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Forensic Technologist/Senior Forensic Technologist in the roles ascribed to him.
