# <u>Vacancy for Post of Neonatal and Paediatric Respiratory Therapist</u> Ministry of Health and Wellness

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Neonatal and Paediatric Respiratory Therapist in the Ministry of Health and Wellness.

# II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45**<sup>th</sup> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

## III. QUALIFICATIONS

- A. Candidates should -
  - (i) be fully registered as a Nurse in accordance with legislation in force in Mauritius;
  - (ii) possess a degree in Respiratory Therapy or Respiratory Care or Critical Care from a recognised institution; and
  - (iii) possess a Certificate in Thermoregulation Cooling Therapy for neonates (Therapeutic Hypothermia) from a recognised institution.

#### OR

Equivalent qualifications to A(ii) and A(iii) above acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

- B. Candidates should -
  - (i) reckon at least two years' experience in Neonatal Intensive Care Unit;
  - (ii) possess good interpersonal and communication skills; and
  - (iii) be computer literate.

#### NOTE

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed.
- 2. <u>Candidates should submit a copy of their Certificate of Registration as</u> Nurse in Mauritius together with their Application Form.
- 3. The onus for the submission of written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualifications (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. **Applications** will not be considered in non-submission of written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- 4. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
- 5. The Commission reserves the right not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

## IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To be responsible to the Consultant-in-Charge in the field of Paediatrics for the performance of Neonatal Services in particular the following duties
  - (i) to assist in obtaining and analysing physiological specimens and interpreting physiological data;
  - (ii) to assist in respiratory therapy which include -
    - (a) the application and monitoring of medical gases and environmental control systems; and
    - (b) advanced mechanical ventilator management;
  - (iii) to assess and monitor neonates/infants/children who need respiratory support, and assist in ventilator management;
  - (iv) to participate in the performance of cardiopulmonary and neurophysiological studies as well as sleep disorder studies; and
  - (v) to assist in high risk neonatal/paediatric transfers, whenever required.

- 2. To organise training for staff in neonatal and paediatric intensive and critical care.
- 3. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 4. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Neonatal and Paediatric Respiratory Therapist in the roles ascribed to him.

# Note |

The Neonatal and Paediatric Respiratory Therapist will be required to work at staggered hours.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs  $28,225 \times 825 - 35,650 \times 900 - 37,450 \times 950 - 42,200 \times 1,300 - 46,100 \times 1,575 - 49,250 \times 1,650 - 54,200 \times 1,700 - 62,700$  a month.
