Vacancy for Post of Dental Surgeon/Senior Dental Surgeon Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Health)

Applications are invited from qualified **Rodriguan** candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Dental Surgeon/Senior Dental Surgeon in the Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Health).

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45th** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should –

- (i) be fully registered as dental surgeon in accordance with legislation in force in Mauritius;
- (ii) be able to communicate effectively and interact with people at all levels; and
- (iii) be computer literate.

NOTE

1. **Candidates should submit a copy of their Certificate of Registration as dental surgeon in Mauritius together with their Application Form.**
2. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
3. **The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed by the closing date.**
4. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
5. The Commission reserves the right not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

1. To be responsible to the Director, Dental Services in Mauritius through the Health Director in Rodrigues and his immediate supervisor/head of institution for the following –
 - (i) to perform dental work;
 - (ii) to manage the dental clinic/clinics including stores and equipment, falling under his responsibility;
 - (iii) to carry out preventive and promotive activities related to oral health; and
 - (iv) to participate in surveys and research, as and when required.
2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Dental Surgeon/Senior Dental Surgeon in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

Dental Surgeons/Senior Dental Surgeons will be required to work in hospitals and Area Health Centres.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 40,300 x 950 – 42,200 x 1,300 – 46,100 x 1,575 – 49,250 x 1,650 – 54,200 x 1,700 – 64,400 x 1,800 – 69,800 x 2,000 – 75,800 x 2,150 – 77,950 a month.

V. FRINGE BENEFITS

Dental Surgeons/Senior Dental Surgeons are entitled to the following benefits:

- (a) 100% duty remission for the purchase of a car with engine capacity of up to 1,500 cc once every seven years;
- (b) loan facilities for the first purchase of a car equivalent to 21 months' salary with interest rate at 3% per annum, refundable in 84 monthly instalments;
- (c) a monthly travelling allowance of Rs 13,200 both for attending duty and for travelling;
- (d) passage benefits at the rate of 5% of annual salary drawn;
- (e) an allowance of Rs 13,500 annually for the purchase of Medical Books, e-materials, journals and other publications;

- (f) refund of the full amount of annual subscription fee payable to the Dental Council of Mauritius; and
- (g) rent free telephone and pre-determined number of free calls depending on posting.

VI. MODE OF APPLICATION

Qualified candidates should submit their application on **PSC Form 7** which may be obtained **either** from the Enquiry Counter of the Ministry of Public Service, Administrative and Institutional Reforms, Ground Floor, Emmanuel Anquetil Building, Port Louis **or** from the Enquiry Counter of the Public Service Commission, 7, Louis Pasteur Street, Forest Side **or** from the Chief Commissioner's Office, Port Mathurin, Rodrigues **or** from the offices of the Mauritius High Commissions/Embassies overseas.

3. Acknowledgement of applications will be made, as far as possible, by **e-mail**. Candidates are, therefore, advised to submit their e-mail address.

Care should be taken to fill in the Application Form correctly. **Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the Application Form may entail elimination of the candidate.**

Applications Forms should reach the Island Chief Executive, Chief Commissioner's Office, Port Mathurin, Rodrigues, **not later than 15 15 hours (local time) on Thursday 05 September 2024.** Application Forms received after the specified closing date and time will **not** be considered.

The post which falls under the Establishment of the Rodrigues Regional Assembly is restricted for service in Rodrigues only. Any request for transfer or promotion to any similar or other posts in Mauritius will not be considered at any stage from any person who is selected for appointment.
