# Vacancy for Post of Research Analyst Ministry of Social Integration, Social Security and National Solidarity (Social Integration Division)

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as **Temporary** Research Analyst in the Ministry of Social Integration, Social Security and National Solidarity (Social Integration Division).

## II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45**<sup>th</sup> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

# III. QUALIFICATIONS

- A. Candidates should possess a degree in Finance or Economics or Statistics <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
- B. Candidates should -
  - (i) reckon at least three years' post-qualification experience in financial or economic or statistical analysis;
  - (ii) possess effective interpersonal and communication skills;
  - (iii) have the ability to work in a team; and
  - (iv) be computer literate.

#### NOTE

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.

- 3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
- 4. The Commission reserves the right:
  - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
  - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

## IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To be responsible to the Head, Technical Unit for
  - (i) the collection and analysis of economic, social, environmental, financial, fiscal and other relevant information and/or data required for the attainment of the objectives of the Ministry and/or the reform programme of the Government;
  - (ii) assisting in the preparation of the Ministry's sectoral and/or national development programmes, policies, plans, Budget and/or international engagements;
  - (iii) monitoring, reporting and evaluating progress in the implementation of the Government Programme, as well as national, sectoral and international engagements, Ministry's plans and/or Budget measures and/or indicators; and
  - (iv) conducting analysis and submitting recommendations in the context of development of quality management systems.
- 2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Research Analyst in the roles ascribed to him

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 27,400 x  $825 - 35,650 \times 900 - 37,450 \times 950 - 42,200 \times 1,300 - 46,100 \times 1,575 - 49,250 \times 1,650 - 54,200 \times 1,700 - 62,700$  a month.

Appointment in a temporary capacity in the grade carries a flat salary of Rs 27,400 a month.
