Enlistment as Trainee Radiation Therapist Ministry of Health and Wellness

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for enlistment as Trainee Radiation Therapist in the Ministry of Health and Wellness.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates should be between $\underline{18}$ and $\underline{35}$ years of age by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should:

A. possess a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics and Physics obtained on one certificate <u>or</u> Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics and Physics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

<u>Note</u>

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" and one subject at "Subsidiary Level" as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

B. be computer literate.

NOTE

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualifications (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, <u>by the closing date</u>.

- 3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
- 4. The Commission reserves the right:
 - (i) to convene **<u>only</u>** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any enlistment following this advertisement.

IV. CONDITIONS OF TRAINING AND ALLOWANCE

Selected candidates will be required to undergo training for a period of at least three years, both theoretical and practical, in all aspects of the work of a Radiation Therapist in Radiotherapy for therapeutic purposes.

During the training period, Trainee Radiation Therapist will draw an allowance in scale Rs $16,525 \ge 260 - 17,045$ a month.

On successful completion of the training, which includes passing the final examination and obtaining the Certificate in Radiotherapy issued by the Ministry of Health and Wellness, Trainee Radiation Therapists will be considered for appointment to the grade of Radiation Therapist, as and when vacancies occur.

The post of Radiation Therapist carries salary in scale Rs $21,150 \ge 325 - 21,475 \ge 375 - 22,225 \ge 400 - 23,425 \ge 525 - 26,050 \ge 675 - 27,400 \ge 825 - 35,650 \ge 900 - 37,450 \ge 950 - 42,200 \ge 1300 - 43,500$ QB 44,800 $\ge 1300 - 46,100$ a month.

V. <u>BOND</u>

Selected candidates will be required, after serving a trial period of fifteen days, to enter into a bond (which will start as from the date of enlistment) together with two sureties in the sum of <u>six hundred and fifty four thousand, six</u> <u>hundred and fifteen rupees (Rs 654, 615)</u> to the effect that they will follow and complete the training and serve in any Government Hospital or Health Institution in Mauritius, Rodrigues and Agalega for a period of three consecutive years as from the date of appointment in the grade of Radiation Therapist.

VI. MODE OF APPLICATION

- 2. Candidates already in the service **<u>should</u>** submit their Application Form <u>**in**</u> <u>**duplicate**</u>, the original to be sent directly to the Secretary, Public Service Commission and the duplicate through their respective Supervising Officer/Responsible Officer.
