# <u>Vacancy for Post of Transport Planner</u> <u>National Land Transport Authority</u> <u>Ministry of Land Transport</u>

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Transport Planner in the National Land Transport Authority of the Ministry of Land Transport.

# II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45**<sup>th</sup> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

## III. QUALIFICATIONS

- A. Candidates should hold the Chartered Membership of the Chartered Institute of Transport (London) or the Chartered Membership of the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport (UK) or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
- B. Candidates should -
  - (i) have a sound knowledge of policies and latest development trends in transport planning and management;
  - (ii) possess good communication and interpersonal skills;
  - (iii) have the ability to work effectively as a team leader; and
  - (iv) be computer literate.

#### NOTE

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests with the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.

- 3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
- 4. The Commission reserves the right:
  - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
  - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

# IV. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

To plan, co-ordinate and implement projects and policies relating to road transport in line with the goals and objectives of the National Land Transport Authority.

## V. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To be responsible to the Road Transport Commissioner for the performance of the following duties
  - (i) to conduct research programmes, appraisals, studies and investigations so as to assist in the formulation of land transport policies;
  - (ii) to investigate, plan and prepare schemes for the development, co-ordination and regulation of land transport systems;
  - (iii) to formulate recommendations on the cost structure of land transport systems, including the identification of economic and social costs, investigation of fares, tariffs and subsidies;
  - (iv) to conduct surveys and transport studies for the purpose of evaluating land transport services and the adequacy or otherwise of the land transport system;
  - (v) to prepare reports relating to transport issues;
  - (vi) to represent the National Land Transport Authority on committees and liaise with other organistions;
  - (vii) to monitor the work and provide guidance to officers of the Planning Section; and
  - (viii) to liaise with the Attorney-General's Office with regard to legal notices or applications for writs served on the Authority and to swear affidavits, if any, on behalf of the Road Transport Commissioner and attend Court/Tribunal whenever necessary.

- 2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Transport Planner in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs  $49,250 \times 1,650 - 54,200 \times 1,700 - 64,400 \times 1,800 - 69,800 \times 2,000 - 75,800 \times 2,150 - 77,950$  a month.
