# <u>Vacancy for Post of Technician (Youth and Sports)</u> <u>Ministry of Youth and Sports</u>

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Technician (Youth and Sports) in the Ministry of Youth and Sports.

#### II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their <u>45</u><sup>th</sup> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

## III. QUALIFICATIONS

**A.** (i) 'Brevet de Technicien' in Electrotechnics awarded jointly by the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate and the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development

or

(ii) Technician Diploma in Applied Electrical Engineering awarded by the City and Guilds of London Institute.

OR

An equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

**B.** Candidates should be computer literate.

## **NOTE**

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. Candidates will be required to pass a swimming test for a distance of at least 25 metres at a stretch conducted by the Public Service Commission.
- 3. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests with the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.

- 4. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
- 5. The Commission reserves the right:
  - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
  - (ii) not to make any appointment following the advertisement.

#### IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

- 1. To be responsible for the maintenance of the swimming pools/stadiums along with all the installations and equipment.
- 2. To be responsible for the filtration plant and continuous circulation of water.
- 3. To conduct water tests.
- 4. To supervise the daily cleaning of the pool and surroundings.
- 5. To operate public address systems and all electrical and electronic devices.
- 6. To give assistance, as and when required, on construction projects pertaining to swimming pools/stadiums in so far as installations and equipment are concerned.
- 7. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 8. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Technician (Youth and Sports) in the roles ascribed to him.

#### Note

Technicians (Youth and Sports) will be required to work at staggered hours including Sundays and Public Holidays.
