Vacancies for Post of Ayurvedic Medical Officer/ Senior Ayurvedic Medical Officer Ministry of Health and Wellness

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Ayurvedic Medical Officer/Senior Ayurvedic Medical Officer in the Ministry of Health and Wellness.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45th** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should –

- (i) be fully registered as Ayurvedic Practitioners with the Traditional Medicine Board of Mauritius in accordance with legislation in force in Mauritius; and
- (ii) be computer literate.

NOTE

1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
2. **Candidates should submit a copy of their Certificate of Registration as Ayurvedic Practitioner in Mauritius together with their Application Form.**
3. **The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed rests with the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed by the closing date.**
4. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
5. The Commission reserves the right not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

1. To be responsible to the Regional Health Director through the Medical Superintendent for –
 - (a) advising generally on Ayurvedic medicine;
 - (b) performing clinical duties to provide Ayurvedic medical treatment;
 - (c) organising training programmes for health personnel in connection with Ayurvedic practice; and
 - (d) providing a comprehensive Ayurvedic service in the region/s.
2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Ayurvedic Medical Officer/Senior Ayurvedic Medical Officer in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 40,300 x 950 – 42,200 x 1,300 – 46,100 x 1,575 – 49,250 x 1,650 – 54,200 x 1,700 – 64,400 x 1,800 – 69,800 x 2,000 – 75,800 x 2,150 – 77,950 a month.

V. FRINGE BENEFITS

Ayurvedic Medical Officer/Senior Ayurvedic Medical Officers are entitled to the following benefits:

- (a) 100% duty remission for the purchase of a car with engine capacity of up to 1500 c.c. once every seven years; or
a monthly car allowance of Rs 3,980 in lieu of remission;
- (b) loan facilities for the first purchase of a car equivalent to 21 months' salary at appropriate interest rate per annum, refundable in 84 monthly instalments;
- (c) a monthly travelling allowance of Rs 13,200 both for attending duty and for official travelling;
- (d) passage benefits at the rate of 5% of annual salary drawn;
- (e) an allowance of Rs 13,500 annually for the purchase of medical books, e-materials, journals and other publications;
- (f) refund of the full amount of annual subscription fee payable to the Medical Council of Mauritius;

- (g) an allowance of Rs 12,130 annually, cumulative over a period of three years, to meet the expenses towards the Continuing Professional Development; and
- (h) rent free telephone and pre-determined number of free calls depending on posting.

VI. MODE OF APPLICATION

2. Candidates may also apply electronically at the Enquiry Counter of the Public Service Commission, 7, Louis Pasteur Street, Forest Side from **09 00 hours to 15 30 hours on weekdays and not later than 15 00 hours on the closing date.**

4. Candidates already in the service **should** also submit a printed copy of their electronic Application Form, **duly signed**, through their respective Supervising Officer/Responsible Officer.
5. Acknowledgement of applications will be made, as far as possible, by **e-mail**. Candidates are, therefore, advised to submit their e-mail address.
