PUBLIC ADVERTISEMENT NO. 13 OF 2026

Enlistment as Trainee Primary School Educator (General Purpose)
Ministry of Education and Human Resource

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for enlistment as Trainee Primary School Educator (General Purpose) in the Ministry of Education and Human Resource.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates should be between **18** and **40** years of age by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

- A. (a) Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics obtained at not more than two sittings or
- (b) Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" and one subject at "Subsidiary Level" as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

- B. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level".

OR

Equivalent qualifications to A and B above acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

- C. Candidates should be computer literate.

NOTE

1. Qualification at A above should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above.
2. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
3. **The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests with the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.**
4. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
5. The Commission reserves the right:
 - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any enlistment following this advertisement.

IV. CONDITIONS OF TRAINING AND ALLOWANCE

Selected candidates will be required to follow a two-year training course, both theoretical and practical, in all aspects of the work of a Primary School Educator leading to the award of a Teacher's Diploma (Primary) at such institution as may be approved.

During the training period, Trainee Primary School Educators will draw an allowance in scale Rs 26,045 x 300 – 26,645 a month. However, for the year 2026, the discounted initial allowance would be Rs 24,216. They will, however, have to meet from their allowance their expenditure on such items as books and such articles of personal equipment as required. Travelling expenses incurred by bus from residence to the place of work/training and back will be refunded.

On successful completion of their training, Trainee Primary School Educators will be considered for appointment to the grade of Primary School Educator, as and when vacancies occur.

The permanent and pensionable post of Primary School Educator carries salary in scale Rs 31,365 x 400 – 31,765 x 425 – 33,040 x 560 – 35,840 x 725 – 37,290 x 925 – 39,140 x 970 – 46,900 x 1,050 – 49,000 x 1,100 – 52,300 QB 53,400 x 1,100 – 54,500 x 1,450 – 57,400 a month.

V. **BOND**

Selected candidates will be required, after serving a satisfactory moratorium period of one month, to enter into a bond (which will start as from the date of enlistment) together with two sureties in the sum of **three hundred and seventy three thousand and six hundred and fifty rupees (Rs 373,650)** to the effect that they will follow and complete the training course and serve in Government Primary Schools for a period of three years as from the date of appointment in the grade of Primary School Educator.

VI. **MODE OF APPLICATION**

1. Qualified candidates should submit their application on **PSC Form 7** which may be obtained **either** from the Enquiry Counter of the Ministry of Public Service and Administrative Reforms, Ground Floor, Emmanuel Anquetil Building, Port Louis **or** from the Enquiry Counter of the Public Service Commission, 7, Louis Pasteur Street, Forest Side **or** from the Chief Commissioner's Office, Port Mathurin, Rodrigues **or** from the offices of the Mauritius High Commissions/Embassies overseas.
2. Candidates already in the service **should** submit their application **in duplicate**, the original to be sent directly to the Secretary, Public Service Commission and the duplicate through their respective Supervising Officer/Responsible Officer.

4. Acknowledgement of applications will be made, as far as possible, by **e-mail**. Candidates are, therefore, advised to submit their e-mail address.

Care should be taken to fill in the Application Form correctly. **Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the Application Form may entail elimination of the candidate.**
