

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION CIRCULAR NOTE NO. 32 OF 2026

Enlistment as Trainee Meteorologist
Mauritius Meteorological Services

Applications are invited from qualified officers of the Mauritius Meteorological Services who wish to be considered for enlistment as Trainee Meteorologist in the Mauritius Meteorological Services.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates should not be more than **40** years of age by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

By selection from among officers who –

- (i) hold a substantive appointment in the Meteorological Technician Cadre or in the Meteorological Telecommunications Technician Cadre; and
- (ii) possess a degree in Meteorology or Mathematics or Physics or Engineering or a Science degree, the major part of which should be Meteorology or Mathematics or Physics from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

NOTE

The onus for the submission of equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests with the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.

IV. CONDITIONS OF TRAINING AND ALLOWANCE

1. Trainee Meteorologists will be required to successfully complete a formal course abroad in weather forecasting leading to Class I Meteorologist standard or its equivalent acceptable to the Government of Mauritius and conforming to World Meteorological Organisation standards.
2. After successful completion of the formal course, Trainee Meteorologists will be required to follow a practical on-the-job training for a period of not less than six months. At the end of the training and on being favourably reported upon, Trainee Meteorologists will be eligible for appointment to the grade of Meteorologist/Senior Meteorologist.
3. During the training period, Trainee Meteorologists will draw an allowance in scale Rs 35,840 x 725 – 37,290 x 925 – 38,215 a month. However, for the year 2026, the discounted initial allowance would be Rs 33,919.

The permanent and pensionable post of Meteorologist/Senior Meteorologist carries salary in scale Rs 42,050 x 970 – 46,900 x 1,050 – 49,000 x 1,100 – 54,500 x 1,450 – 58,850 x 1,750 – 62,350 x 1,850 – 67,900 x 1,900 – 75,500 x 2,250 – 86,750 a month.

V. **BOND**

Selected candidates will be required, after serving a satisfactory trial period of one month, to enter into a bond (which will start as from date of enlistment) together with two sureties in the sum of **eight hundred thousand rupees (Rs 800,000)** to the effect that they will follow and complete the course of training and thereafter serve the Mauritius Meteorological Services for a period of three years as from the date of appointment in the grade of Meteorologist/Senior Meteorologist.

VI. **MODE OF APPLICATION**

3. Candidates **should** also submit a printed copy of their Application Form, **duly signed**, through the Director, Mauritius Meteorological Services.

Online Applications should be submitted **not later than 15 00 hours (local time) on Monday 29 June 2026**. Applications received after the specified closing date and time will **not** be considered.
