Vacancy for Post of Healthcare Technologist
Ministry of Health and Wellness

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Healthcare Technologist in the Ministry of Health and Wellness.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45th** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

A. By selection from among candidates who –

- (i) possess a diploma in Electrical and Electronic Engineering or Electromechanical Engineering and Automation or Electrical and Automation Engineering from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission

OR

- (ii) are an Associate of the British Institute of Dental and Surgical Technologists.

B. Candidates should be computer literate.

Note

1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
2. **The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests with the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.**
3. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.

4. The Commission reserves the right:
- (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

NOTE

Selected candidates will be appointed in a temporary capacity in the first instance and will be required to undergo, under the supervision of the Senior Healthcare Technologist, on-the-job training, both theoretical and practical, in all aspects of the work of a Healthcare Technologist, for a period of at least twelve months in the following –

- (i) operating room equipment: anaesthesia machines, operating tables, surgical instruments of all specialities (General Surgery, Orthopaedic, Neurosurgical, ENT, Gynaecology, Ophthalmology and Cardiac Surgeries);
- (ii) critical care equipment: ICU and NICU ventilators, BIPAP, CPAP and other life support system;
- (iii) medical gas management system: manifolds, oxygen, compressor and vacuum plants, pipeline distribution system and alarms including back up supply;
- (iv) endoscopic equipment: GIT scopes, arthroscopes, bronchoscopes, hysteroscopes, neuroendoscopes including video systems;
- (v) operating microscopes: ENT, ophthalmology, neurology and microsurgery;
- (vi) surgical drilling and cutting tools: pneumatic and battery operated drill and saw for Orthopaedic, Cardiac and Neurosurgical surgeries; and
- (vii) any other related equipment in a clinical setting.

On satisfactory completion of the training and on being favourably reported upon, they will be considered for appointment to the grade of Healthcare Technologist in a substantive capacity, as and when vacancies occur.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

1. To be responsible to the Superintendent, Healthcare Technology Workshop for –
 - (i) assisting the Senior Healthcare Technologist in the discharge of his duties;
 - (ii) the maintenance and repair of surgical instruments and medical equipment and medical gas system and plants;
 - (iii) providing guidance and training of junior staff;
 - (iv) carrying out preventive maintenance works on equipment, regular verification, testing and calibration;
 - (v) updating of inventory of tools and equipment;
 - (vi) carrying out survey and submit report;
 - (vii) assisting in delivery of equipment from suppliers, verification, testing and commissioning; and
 - (viii) ensuring the smooth functioning of relevant equipment at hospital level.
2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Healthcare Technologist in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 32,190 x 425 – 33,040 x 560 – 35,840 x 725 – 37,290 x 925 – 39,140 x 970 – 46,900 x 1,050 – 49,000 x 1,100 – 54,500 x 1,450 – 55,950 a month.

However, for the year 2026, the discounted initial salary would be Rs 30,296.

V. MODE OF APPLICATION

1. Qualified candidates should submit their application on **PSC Form 7** which may be obtained **either** from the Enquiry Counter of the Ministry of Public Service and Administrative Reforms, Ground Floor, Emmanuel Anquetil Building, Port Louis **or** from the Enquiry Counter of the Public Service Commission, 7, Louis Pasteur Street, Forest Side **or** from the Chief Commissioner's Office, Port Mathurin, Rodrigues **or** from the offices of the Mauritius High Commissions/Embassies overseas.

2. Candidates already in the service **should** submit their Application Form **in duplicate**, the original to be sent directly to the Secretary, Public Service Commission and the duplicate through their respective Supervising Officer/Responsible Officer.
