

**PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION CIRCULAR NOTE NO. 30 OF 2026**

**Vacancy for Post of Assistant Supervisor (The Arts)**  
**Ministry of Education and Human Resource**

Applications are invited from qualified officers of the Ministry of Education and Human Resource who wish to be considered for appointment as Assistant Supervisor (The Arts) in the Ministry.

**II. QUALIFICATIONS**

By selection from among officers of the Ministry not below the grade of Primary School Educator and Primary School Educator (Oriental Languages) who hold a substantive appointment in their respective grade and who –

- (i) possess a Cambridge School Certificate with a credit in Art or Art and Design obtained at not more than two sittings or passes not below Grade C in Art or Art and Design obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission; and
- (ii) reckon at least 10 years’ experience in the teaching of Creative Education/The Arts in a primary school, acquired after appointment in a substantive capacity in their respective grade.

**NOTE**

1. Candidates should produce written evidence of experience claimed.
2. **The onus for the submission of written evidence of experience claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests with the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of experience claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.**

**III. DUTIES AND SALARY**

1. To assist the Supervisor (The Arts) in the organisation and supervision of the teaching of The Arts in primary schools.
2. To ensure the implementation of The Arts programmes and projects in the primary sector.

3. To assist in the organisation and running of courses in The Arts for teachers and officers in other grades in the primary sector.
4. To assist curriculum panels in developing and monitoring the implementation of curriculum materials, evaluate curriculum materials and propose modifications, as and when required.
5. To act as facilitator for the use of Performing Arts with a view to enhancing socialisation and linguistic skills for personality development.
6. To participate in courses at regional and national levels, as and when required.
7. To visit primary schools in connection with the teaching of the subject.
8. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
9. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Assistant Supervisor (The Arts) in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 35,840 x 725 – 37,290 x 925 – 39,140 x 970 – 46,900 x 1,050 – 49,000 x 1,100 – 54,500 x 1,450 – 58,850 x 1,750 – 62,350 x 1,850 – 66,050 a month.

However, for the year 2026, the discounted initial salary would be Rs 33,919.
