Vacancies for Post of Medical and Health Officer/ Senior Medical and Health Officer (to be restyled General Practitioner) Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Health)

Applications are invited from qualified **Rodriguan** candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Medical and Health Officer/Senior Medical and Health Officer (*to be restyled General Practitioner*) in the Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Health).

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45th** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should be fully registered as medical practitioners in accordance with legislation in force in Mauritius.

NOTE

1. **Candidates should submit a copy of their Certificate of Registration as medical practitioner in Mauritius together with their Application Form.**
2. Candidates will be required to take part in a written examination conducted by the Public Service Commission in collaboration with an internationally recognised institution to assess their knowledge, skills and competency in the fields of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, General Surgery, Orthopaedics, Paediatrics, General Medicine, Community Health and their communication and linguistic skills.
3. The Commission reserves the right not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

IV. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

To be responsible for the delivery of continuing quality health care services.

V. DUTIES AND SALARY

1. To be responsible to his immediate supervisor and ultimately to the head of institution for the following –
 - (i) to perform clinical and public health duties including family planning; and
 - (ii) to participate in research activities and medical audit.

2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Medical and Health Officer/Senior Medical and Health Officer (*to be restyled General Practitioner*) in the roles ascribed to him.

The permanent and pensionable post carries salary in scale Rs 53,400 x 1,100 – 54,500 x 1,450 – 58,850 x 1,750 – 62,350 x 1,850 – 67,900 x 1,900 – 75,500 x 2,250 – 86,750 x 2,500 – 94,250 x 2,750 – 102,500 a month.

However, for the year 2026, the discounted initial salary would be Rs 50,330.

NOTE

Medical and Health Officer/Senior Medical and Health Officers (*to be restyled General Practitioners*) will be required to work in Community Health Centres, Area Health Centres and within the community services.

1. When posted to a Hospital, Medical and Health Officer/Senior Medical and Health Officers (*to be restyled General Practitioners*) will be required to perform clinical duties on a six-month rotational basis in at least the following units:- Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Paediatrics, Accident and Emergency, Anaesthesia and Orthopaedics.
2. When posted to Community Health Centres, they will be required to –
 - a. perform curative, preventive and health promotive and rehabilitative duties;
 - b. participate in training and research programmes; and
 - c. ensure community participation in health activities.

Note

Medical and Health Officer/Senior Medical and Health Officers (*to be restyled General Practitioners*) will be required to work on shift covering a 24-hour service including Saturdays, Sundays, Public Holidays and officially declared cyclone days.

VI. FRINGE BENEFITS

Medical and Health Officer/Senior Medical and Health Officers (*to be restyled General Practitioners*) are entitled to the following benefits:-

- (a) 100% duty remission for the purchase of a car with engine capacity of up to 1,500 cc/150kW once every seven years;

or

a monthly car allowance of Rs 4,975 in lieu of duty remission;

- (b) loan facilities for the first purchase of a car equivalent to 21 months' salary with interest at the prescribed rate per annum refundable in 84 monthly instalments;
- (c) a monthly travelling allowance of Rs 15,180 both for attending duty and for official travelling;
- (d) passage benefits at the rate of 5% of annual salary drawn;
- (e) an allowance of Rs 14,500 annually for the purchase of medical books, e-materials, journals and other publications;
- (f) refund of the full amount of annual subscription payable to the Medical Council of Mauritius;
- (g) an allowance of up to Rs 13,345 annually, cumulative over a period of four years, to meet expenses in connection with Continuing Professional Development; and
- (h) rent free telephone and pre-determined number of free calls depending on posting.

VII. SELECTION PROCEDURE AND EXAMINATION ARRANGEMENTS

1. The selection procedure will comprise a written examination conducted by the Public Service Commission in collaboration with an internationally recognised institution to assess the knowledge, skills and competency of the candidates in the fields of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, General Surgery, Orthopaedics, Paediatric, General Medicine, Community Health and their communication and linguistic skills.
2. Candidates will be informed in due course of the exact date and venue of the examination.
3. Candidates who are overseas should make their own arrangements to come and sit for the examination.

VIII. MODE OF APPLICATION

1. Qualified candidates should submit their application on **PSC Form 7** which may be obtained **either** from the Enquiry Counter of the Ministry of Public Service and Administrative Reforms, Ground Floor, Emmanuel Anquetil Building, Port Louis **or** from the Enquiry Counter of the Public Service Commission, 7, Louis Pasteur Street, Forest Side **or** from the Chief Commissioner's Office, Port Mathurin, Rodrigues **or** from the offices of the Mauritius High Commissions/Embassies overseas.

3. Acknowledgement of applications will be made, as far as possible, by **e-mail**. Candidates are, therefore, advised to submit their e-mail address.

Care should be taken to fill in the Application Form correctly. **Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the Application Form may entail elimination of the candidate.**

Application Forms should reach the Island Chief Executive, Chief Commissioner’s Office, Port Mathurin, Rodrigues, **not later than 15 15 hours (local time) on Thursday 24 September 2026**. Application Forms received after the specified closing date and time will **not** be considered.

The post which falls under the Establishment of the Rodrigues Regional Assembly is restricted for service in Rodrigues only. Any request for transfer or promotion to any similar posts or other posts in Mauritius will not be considered at any stage from any person who is selected for appointment.
