Enlistment as Trainee Cartographer **Ministry of Housing and Lands**

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for enlistment as Trainee Cartographer in the Ministry of Housing and Lands.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45th** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

- A. (a) Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including Geometrical and Mechanical Drawing obtained at not more than two sittings or
- (b) Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including Geometrical and Mechanical Drawing obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject or
- (c) An equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal Level” and one subject at “Subsidiary Level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

- B. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at Principal Level in at least two subjects including Mathematics and Geometrical and Mechanical Drawing obtained on one certificate or Passes in at least two subjects including Mathematics and Geometrical and Mechanical Drawing obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level” or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Note 1

In the absence of candidates possessing a pass in Geometrical and Mechanical Drawing at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate or the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level” Examinations, consideration will be given to those who possess passes in Mathematics and one Science subject obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate or the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level” Examinations.

Note 2

Qualification at **A** above should have been obtained prior to qualification at **B** above.

NOTE

1. **The onus for the submission of equivalence of qualifications (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests with the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.**
2. Candidates may be required to take part in a written examination.
3. The Commission reserves the right:
 - (i) to convene **only** the best qualified candidates for interview; and
 - (ii) not to make any enlistment following this advertisement.

IV. CONDITIONS OF TRAINING AND ALLOWANCE

Selected candidates will be required to undergo training for at least two years in survey draughtsmanship and the production of maps.

During the training period, Trainee Cartographers will draw an allowance in scale Rs 26,045 x 300 – 26,645 a month. However, for the year 2026, the discounted initial allowance would be Rs 24,216.

On successful completion of the training, Trainee Cartographers will be eligible for appointment to the grade of Cartographer/Senior Cartographer, as and when vacancies occur.

The permanent and pensionable post of Cartographer/Senior Cartographer carries salary in scale Rs 29,915 x 350 – 30,965 x 400 – 31,765 x 425 – 33,040 x 560 – 35,840 x 725 – 37,290 x 925 – 39,140 x 970 – 46,900 x 1,050 – 49,000 x 1,100 – 54,500 x 1,450 – 58,850 x 1,750 – 62,350 x 1,850 – 64,200 QB 66,050 a month.

V. MODE OF APPLICATION

1. Qualified candidates should submit their application on **PSC FORM 7** which may be obtained **either** from the Enquiry Counter of the Ministry of Public Service and Administrative Reforms, Ground Floor, Emmanuel Anquetil Building, Port Louis **or** from the Enquiry Counter of the Public Service Commission, 7, Louis Pasteur Street, Forest Side **or** from the Chief Commissioner's Office, Port Mathurin, Rodrigues **or** from the offices of the Mauritius High Commissions/Embassies overseas.
2. Candidates already in the service **should** submit their Application Form **in duplicate**, the original to be sent directly to the Secretary, Public Service Commission and the duplicate through their respective Supervising Officer/Responsible Officer.

4. Acknowledgement of applications will be made, as far as possible, by **e-mail**. Candidates are, therefore, advised to submit their e-mail address.
